

Dear Travel Advisor,

If you have clients traveling within the US, please share this important information with them regarding their upcoming travels. For travel completed by May 6, 2025, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo ID) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

**Please Note: Effective for travel May 7, 2025 forward**, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while traveling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. To ensure a smooth travel experience, your client should check if their current ID meets the REAL ID standards. If it does not, they should visit their state's Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) website to learn how to upgrade to a REAL ID-compliant credential.
