CURRENT OFFERINGS

AFCT (Armed Forces Classification Test) – (2.5 HOURS) Like the ASVAB, the AFCT measures a Marine’s aptitude and abilities necessary for successful performance on the job and during formal school training. The AFCT is a battery of multiple-choice tests to members trying to improve their ASVAB scores to qualify for Class “A” Schools and Officer Candidate School (OCS). This exam is administered to examinees who may need to improve their previous ASVAB or AFCT scores.

AFCT Schedule = *ASP Students have Priority = Daytime Evening

DLAB (Defense Language Aptitude Battery) – (1.5 HOURS) The DLAB is a military administered language exam that focuses on measuring a person’s ability to learn a language. It is a required test for USMC and USN personnel who are looking to attend a Defense Language School, such as Defense Language Institute (DLI), and is required for certain military communities in the application process.

DLPT (Defense Language Proficiency Test) – (7.5 HOURS) The DLPT is designed for USMC and USN personnel who are already fluent in a specific foreign language needed by their designated Service Branch, and it is designed to test the individual’s current knowledge of a specific language.

APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED

Tests are by appointments only. Contact the Testing Office for required forms and scheduling of your test(s). All forms **must** be received **two business days prior** to testing date(s). **No -shows must wait two weeks from previous test date to reschedule.**

OTHER REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION

- ✓ All tests at the testing center are computer-based exams that require network connectivity. Interruptions to the network may require testers to reschedule.
- ✓ Unofficial scores can be provided at the testing center for Language tests immediately following test completion. AFCT scores are only posted in MCTFS 3270 official military records and MOL (2-4 weeks after testing).
- ✓ Testers **MUST** arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time for check-in. All exams have a hard start time at 0800 except AFCT (1300) and AU/My Learning (1000).
- ✓ Testers are strictly prohibited from bringing anything into the testing center except their current military ID. On-site lockers are available to secure items.

ACADEMIC SKILLS PROGRAM (ASP)

Education Assistance Branch ♦ MCB Camp Lejeune ♦ MCAS New River (REV 20231114)

The ASP is an on-duty or off-duty education program designed to improve the competencies of active duty and reserve enlisted personnel/dependents in the academic skills of math and reading. The ASP is for all active duty and reserve military students. Students who are using tuition assistance for the first time, and/or have a GT of 99 or below, and/or failed to achieve a grade of 10.2 on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) will be given priority. For TA purposes only, should a Marine wish to pursue two courses per term after the initial completion of the first TA course, satisfactory completion of ASP is required prior to submitting any requests for Tuition Assistance.

Eligibility

- Service members with a GT score of 99 or below has priority.
- Family members with a Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) score of 10.2 or below has priority
- All other submissions will be granted a seat on a space-available basis before the class start date.
- An ASP Authorization Form must be completed and submitted to the Education Assistance Branch (EAB) with the Commanding Officer's endorsement prior to the course start date.

General Information

- Classes are conducted by Coastal Carolina Community College (CCCC) in the John A. Lejeune Education Center, 825 Stone Street, MCB Camp Lejeune in Room 220 and Room 423.
- All holidays will be observed in accordance with installation schedules and policies.
- The schedule is published annually, however, it is subject to change. Please confirm with EAB for scheduling.
